Today is the Feast of Oliver Plunkett, a patron saint of the diocese of Meath. His life will be remembered at Masses today. Relics of St Oliver are in the Cathedral altar and a set of vestments he wore are on display in the Cathedral Museum.

Facts about Oliver Plunkett:

- 1625, Born in Loughcrew, Oldcastle Co. Meath
- Ordained a priest after studying at the Irish College in Rome in 1654.
- Ordained a bishop in 1669.
- Arrested and executed in London for charges of treason on 1st July 1681 - 331 years ago today!
- Beatified in 1920 and Canonised in 1975.
