The Annual Mass for parishioners who died during the past year takes place on Wednesday 18th November at 7.30pm in the Cathedral.

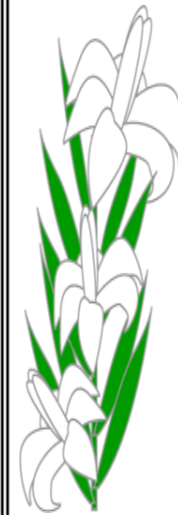
Parish Programme—Confirmation

Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

- From twelve o'clock noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November, all who have confession, received Holy Communion and prayed for the pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1 November to 8 November.
- The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1 to 8 November.
