Pilgrimage to Compostella



30 pilgrims from Mullingar head off to do the Camino on Thursday morning. They will walk 120 kilometres to the city of Compostella. Mullingar's heritage is closely associated with the Camino and Compostella as the bodies of the Augustinian monks found on Austin Friars Street in 1996 had scallop shells, suggesting they had done the walk. Fr Michael thanks parishioners for the generous donations received on the Feast of St James this year which are going towards a memorial for the monks near their grave in the Cathedral Grounds.

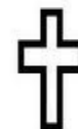
