- * may not use church railings, gates or property to display posters or advertisements
- * should give written notice to the Parish Office of their intention to collect

Parish Payment to Diocese

Each parish in our diocese makes an annual payment to the diocese for the provision of various services such as Accord & Marriage Tribunal, Child Protection & Safeguarding, Primary & Secondary School Catechists, Bishops Conference.
