Kilronan (after 11am Mass in Gainstown)

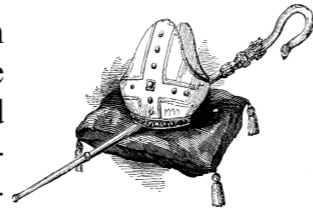
Marlinstown 12.15pm
