Fifth national collection to pay for papal visit

The Catholic Church in Ireland is to hold a further national collection to help defray remaining costs from the World Meeting of Families (WMOF2018) and the visit to Ireland of Pope Francis last August. It will take place at all Catholic Churches next weekend Spokesman for the Catholic bishops Martin Long said "the World Meeting of Families deficit is in the region of €4 million. To date €15.4 million has been raised by previous national collections and other donations." The overall cost to the church of the WMOF2018 and the visit to Pope Francis was €19.4 million, he said.
