What is the Eucharistic Congress?



The International Eucharistic Congress is a week-long event which will be held in Dublin on 10 - 17 June. The first six days will take place at the RDS. Each day of the week has a theme and the programme for each day will centre on that theme. For example, Tuesday 12 June will be Family Day. There will be talks and workshops throughout the arena, looking at how the Eucharist can enrich marriage and family life. On Thursday 14 June, the focus will be on Reconciliation and the Eucharist. Mullingar Parish is keen to take an active part in the Congress. It is a chance for us to deepen our faith in the Eucharist and to celebrate this faith with people from home and much further afield who will come to Ireland for the Congress. The parish will be twinned with several countries to host visitors to the event.
