




## Mullingar Parish Pilgrimage to Lourdes with

### **Proposed School Changes**



With the approval of Bishop Smith who is Patron of the schools and pending the approval of the Department of Education, the following changes are proposed from 1st September 2013.

Scoil Mhuire (CBS) will enrol boys and girls from Junior Infants up to Sixth Class.

Presentation Senior School will enrol girls and boys from Third Class to Sixth Class.

Presentation Junior School will continue to enrol Junior Infant boys and girls. Boys will continue to have the option of moving after First Class to Scoil Mhuire or of continuing in Second Class in Presentation Junior.

In the coming months the Boards of Management will work to ensure they are ready for these proposed changes and we thank all who give so generously of their time to serve on the Boards.
