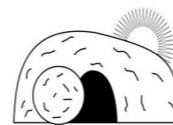
Today is one of the five Offering Days for the Support of the Bishop and Priests of the parish. Thank you for contributing towards your parish.

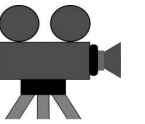
