The Year of Faith

Who can be baptised, and what is required of a candidate? Any person who is not yet baptised can be baptized. The only prerequisite for Baptism is Christian faith, which must be Christmas Party on the 27th January at 2pm professed publicly at the Baptism. A person who turns to Christianity is not just changing a world view. They travel a path of learning (the catechumenate), in which they become a new person through personal conversion, but especially through the gift of Baptism.
