## Presentation Day

Next Thursday, 21st November is the Feast of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Our Cathedral has a side altar dedicated to St Anne, which beautifully depicts this feast in one of Boris Anrep's mosaics.

The Presentation Sisters first came to Mullingar in 1825 and opened a school here the following year. Their foundress, Nano Nagle from Cork, was declared Venerable by Pope Francis on 31st October this year as part of the process of canonisation.
