Faith and the Eucharist

"The sacramental character of faith finds its highest expression in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is a precious nourishment for faith: an encounter with Christ truly present in the supreme act of his love, the life-giving gift of himself. In the Eucharist we find the intercession of faith's two dimensions. On the one hand, there is the dimension of history: the Eucharist is an act of remembrance, a making present of the mystery in which the past, as an event of death and resurrection, demonstrates its ability to open up a future, to foreshadow ultimate fulfilment. The liturgy reminds us of this by its repetition of the word hodie, the "today" of the mysteries of salvation. On the other hand, we also find the dimension which leads from the visible world to the invisible. In the Eucharist we learn to see the heights and depths of reality. The bread and wine are changed into the body and blood of Christ, who becomes present in his Passover to the Father: this movement draws us, body and soul, into the movement of all creation towards its fulfilment in God." from "The Light of Faith" **Pope Francis.**

National Heritage Week, August 17th-25th

Discover the past. Build the Future

As part of Heritage week people are encouraged to embrace the heritage of their local environment.

The Cathedral Museum will open on Wednesday 21st August, from 2.30 - 5pm. Admission - free.

After the Vigil Mass next Saturday evening (August 24th) the Cathedral Camino Garden will be officially opened.

The Spanish Ambassador to Ireland will be our guest for the occasion. Bishop Smith will bless the garden and the fountain memorial. The garden draws attention to visitors to the Cathedral grounds of the Augustinian monks whose remains were discovered on Austin Friars Street in 1996. Shells found alongside the remains, indicate that the monks were pilgrims to the city of Santiago de Compostela in Northern Spain.
