School News

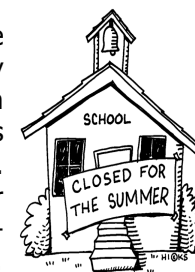
This week the Department of Education approved the following changes to our three town centre Catholic schools from 1st September 2013.
