Every year a number of adults present themselves for baptism in our parish. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the programme through which an adult comes into full communion in the Catholic Church. In some cases this may include those who have received Baptism but have not yet been confirmed or made First Holy Communion. The period of preparation involves meeting over a few months for teaching and formation in the Catholic faith. At the moment enrolment for RCIA is taking place.
