Countdown to Outdoor Mass... 10th June



To mark the beginning of the Eucharistic Congress on Sunday 10 June, the Cathedral will “relocate” to Pearse Street for the celebration of Mass at 11am. The music for the Mass will be provided by the Cathedral Choir, the Cathedral Choristers, Mullingar Town Band and the Cathedral Gospel Choir.

We have asked children in primary schools to join us for the Mass and to make flags at home or at school for the occasion. Following the Mass, a procession of the Blessed Sacrament will make its way through the town, leading to the steps of the Cathedral. There will be no 12.30pm Mass on that day. Ministers of the Eucharist and Ministers of the Word due on the 11am & 12.30pm for that day are asked to attend the rehearsal which will take place in the Cathedral at 7pm on Tuesday 5th June.
